Thomas Widdershoven (Maastricht 1960) studied philosophy, art and graphic design. He is a designer and curator. In 1993 he founded Thonik together with Nikki Gonnissen. The studio collaborates with clients and creatives in design, e-culture, architecture, art, film and advertising.

Thonik couples a strategic approach to an adventurous exploration of media. Clients include Hyundai Department Stores, Seoul, Museum M+ Hong Kong, Museum Boijmans van Beuningen, the City of Amsterdam, the Dutch Socialist Party (SP) and the Dutch TV network VPRO. Thonik has had solo exhibitions at the Shanghai Art Museum, The Venice Architecture Biennial, Spiral Art Center Tokyo, Sfera Kyoto, Moti Breda, Galerie Anatome and Institut Néerlandais Paris.

Thonik's work is part of the permanent collection of the Centre Pompidou in Paris.

In 2013 Thomas became creative director and chair at Design Academy Eindhoven. There he initiated a series of exhibitions, in collaboration with the Van Abbemuseum Eindhoven. Thing Nothing (2015) addresses the relation between form and counter-form, between the real and the virtual, between technological possibilities and moral issues. Thing Nothing follows on from Self Unself (2013) - about the unselfish inclination of present day designers, and Sense Nonsense (2014) - which embraced the irrational as a creative force. Together this trilogy explores and forecasts the next generation of designers and how they are positioning themselves in the always-evolving field of design.

At the end of his tenure he resigned to design studio Thonik.
